4. Lincoln Blvd. Sewers

Abandonment of Lincoln Park's gravity sewers located on Lincoln Blvd. and connection of remaining residences to a new force main is being planned for inclusion with the Two Bridges Road Bridge Project. Lincoln Park has been coordinating with the County to issue a change order for this purpose.

FFY 17 UASI Grant

All of this \$150,000 grant has been spent on various facility target hardening items and has been closed out.

6. Covid-19 (Update)

We have been continuing with our alternate work schedule as previously described by Ernie DeGraw's April 3, 2020 memo. All TBSA employees are generally healthy. Authority facilities are being maintained and have been operating fairly well, with minimal interruptions.
